## CSAM introduces Environmental Safety in Construction course in Winnipeg and Brandon

The Construction Safety Association of Manitoba (CSAM) is pleased to present Environmental Safety in Construction - a one-day training course that's structured around growing environmental safety issues in and solutions for the construction industry.

This course has been developed in conjunction with the Manitoba Environmental Industries Association, supported by CSAM's Advisory and Divisional Committees, and structured by industry experts that represent different areas of environmental safety in construction. Course content includes hazardous materials handling, storage and disposal; WDG (recycled, landfilled, asbestos, C&D waste); Petroleum storage; when to report a spill (and to who); TDG regulations; contaminated sites legislation; and industrial hygiene.

THE SAFETY PASS is an excellent orientation program for any personnel entering a construction site.

THE SAFETY PASS is convenient, easy-to-use, easy-to-understand, and is interactive and accessible 24/7. Upon completion of the online training, participants will be able to print off a certificate and will also be sent a hard hat decal.

The program provides the basics in construction safety and requires 100% mastery of 13 modules which take approximately two to four hours to complete.

## CSAM to roll out Working at Heights training standard as best practice for the construction industry

The Construction Safety Association of Manitoba (CSAM) is pleased to announce that the Working at Heights training standard will now be introduced to and implemented throughout the construction industry as a “best practice” for training in Manitoba.

CSAM will be recognized as the “gate keeper” of the voluntary working at heights training standard – meaning that the association will work with training providers that wish to adopt the standard, as stated in the Working at Heights Training Provider & Program Standard documents.

Training providers that submit their training and meet the standard will be added on the official Approved Working at Heights Training Providers list, which will be promoted on CSAM’s website, [constructionsafety.ca](http://constructionsafety.ca).

The next step is to work with the construction industry to adopt this training standard.

**CSAM is looking for interested member companies to participate in this initiative and help take the lead in making working at heights training meet a set standard in the industry.**

Mike Jones, Executive Director of the Construction Safety Association of Manitoba, is pleased that this initiative confident that this initiative for setting a standard for working at heights training.

“The Working at Heights training program standard is designed to structure and support offered working at heights training programs with a set of guidelines that constitutes a set standard in Manitoba,” says Jones. “Other specialty training programs, such as scaffolding and confined space, are next on the roster for review and it’s only a matter of time before these training standards are authorized by SAFE Work Manitoba; so the time is now to step up and make a positive impact by adopting “best practice” training in your workplace.”

CSAM has already begun working with one of its member companies who are committed to meeting the standard. The process in getting your working at heights training reviewed and approved takes about two to four weeks.

To get this process started, interested companies/training providers need to compare their current training program with the Working at Heights Training Program & Provider Standard documents, then submit those training document to CSAM for review.

Throughout the review process, CSAM will be working openly and transparently with the company to ensure that all requirements are met and both parties are satisfied that the training meets the standard.
